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## Proposal Format

Make sure your proposal is feasible to present in a 60-minute session. Part of effective professional development is providing meaningful presentation materials and online resources that allow the participants to further their learning. It is expected that presenters provide electronic presentation materials and/or handouts before, during or after the event. Presenters are expected to develop effective, interactive activities to ensure the workshop attendee the best professional development opportunity.

## Speaker Registration Information

ALL accepted presenters MUST remit a VISION 2018 Speaker Registration fee. The discount Speaker Registration fee is \$295 for ACTE members and \$475 for non-members. This fee must be paid by July 13, 2018. Speakers who pay after this date will be required to pay the full prevailing registration rate.

## How to Apply

You must submit your proposal using our online system. Emailed, faxed and mailed proposals will not be accepted. By submitting a proposal you agree to present at any time during the meeting. Program sessions will be scheduled on Thursday, November 29; Friday, November 30; and Saturday, December 1. Sessions will be 60 minutes in length. Please be sure to design your presentation slides to 4:3 format.

## Proposal Questions

The information gathered during this process will be used to promote the programming at VISION and to prepare marketing materials. Please be sure that the information you provide is complete, accurate and grammatically correct.

**Presentation Title:** 10 word maximum; may be edited for publication

**Short Session Description:** 50 words maximum; may be edited for publication

**Category:** Choose one of 11 ACTE Divisions

**High-quality CTE Framework:** Choose up to two

**Session learning objectives:** 3-5 specific objectives that describe what participants will learn or gain from the session

**Detailed Description** (500 words maximum): Provide a more thorough description of the content and structure of your session. You must address the evidence base for the presentation, audience engagement strategies, the practical application or tools/resources to be provided, and how the session topic reflects innovation or new ideas or approaches within CTE.
