The Licensed Caregiver of the Year Award recognizes a licensed staff member who provides excellent clinical care while also demonstrating professionalism and leadership.

Eligible Nominees:

A licensed caregiver in a member community

Criteria:

- Exhibits a strong dedication and skill in performing duties in the care of older adults
- Demonstrates acute skill and dedication to performing duties and interacting with older adults in a manner that upholds dignity and self-value
- Exudes professionalism; building and promoting caregiving skills and standards among their team
- Strives to anticipate and problem solve proactively so that needs and expectations are exceeded

Application Requirements:

- Application Form
- Include two letters of reference from relevant sources that can speak to the nominee's accomplishments. The letters should address the following:
 - Illustrate the individual's dedication and skill in performing duties related to the care of older adults.
 - Detail how the individual consistently goes above and beyond expectations in their roles and responsibilities.
 - Describe how the individual serves as a role model and stands tall in their team

- How does the individual embody high standards of professionalism as they guide the team they serve?
- Share how the individual anticipates and proactively problem solves, so that needs and expectations are met.
