Eligible Nominees:

A CEO, Executive Director, Board Member, Benefactor, or Trustee in a member community

Criteria:

- History of commitment, leadership, and involvement with broad-reaching impact for the advancement of serving older adults
- Significant involvement in advocacy and grassroots initiative to support aging services at the state and/or national level
- Successful contributions to improving quality and fostering a better community-wide understanding of aging services
- Distinguished record of service and support to the LeadingAge PA vision and mission
- Outstanding leadership that resulted in the advancement of specific goals and objectives of the community

Application Requirements:

- Application Form

- Include three letters of reference from relevant sources that can speak to the nominee's accomplishments. The letters should address:
 - Describe the individual's commitment, leadership and involvement with broad-reaching impact for the advancement of serving older adults
 - Describe the individual's involvement in advocacy initiatives to support aging services at the state and/or national level
 - Discuss the individual's contributions to improving quality and fostering a better community-wide understanding of aging services.
 - Share about the individual's record of service and support to LeadingAge PA's vision and mission.
 - Share about the individual's leadership that resulted in the advancement of specific goals and objectives of the organization.
