The Staff Member of the Year Award recognizes an individual who exhibits excellence within their role and enhances their member community through exceptional service to staff, residents/clients, and families served.

Eligible Nominees:

An individual who is not in a supervisory position and does not provide direct care to residents/clients

Criteria:

- Serves as an outstanding role model and stands tall in their team
- Displays an outstanding commitment to residents/clients and other teammates in their member community
- Initiates action to enhance and enrich the lives of residents/clients, or the community culture
- Provides exceptional service to the member community
- Consistently goes above and beyond expectations in their role and responsibilities

Application Requirements:

- Application Form
- Include two letters of reference from relevant sources that can speak to the nominee's accomplishments. The letters should address:
 - Illustrate the individual's dedication and skill in performing duties related to the care of older adults.
 - Detail how the individual consistently goes above and beyond expectations in their roles and responsibilities.
 - Describe how the individual serves as a role model and stands tall in their team
 - How does the individual embody high standards of professionalism as they guide the team they serve?

- Share how the individual anticipates and proactively problem solves, so that needs and expectations are met.
